

ORDINANCE NO. 66 - 5

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW BERLIN, UNION COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 66-4 WHICH APPROVED A PETITION FOR ANNEXATION TO THE BOROUGH, AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE SECRETARY OR SOLICITOR TO WITHDRAW SAID PETITION FROM THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS

WHEREAS, a petition was presented to the August 3, 1966 meeting of Borough Council for annexation to the Borough of a portion of Limestone Township containing 2.46 acres, more or less; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council duly enacted on August 3, 1966 an Ordinance approving the said petition for annexation, and authorizing and directing the Secretary to certify said petition into the Court of Quarter Sessions in and for Union County; and

WHEREAS, the same petitioners have now filed a further petition with Borough Council requesting Council to take no final action on said annexation and to disregard the original petition for annexation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Council of the Borough of New Berlin, Union County, Pennsylvania as follows:

1. Ordinance No. 66-4 enacted by Borough Council August 3, 1966 is hereby repealed.

2. The Borough Secretary or the Borough Solicitor is hereby authorized and directed to withdraw said petition for annexation from the Court of Quarter Sessions in and for Union County, Pennsylvania.
