

ORDINANCE NO. 66-1

BOROUGH OF NEW BERLIN
UNION COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE OFFICES OF
SECRETARY AND TREASURER TO BE HELD BY
THE SAME PERSON

WHEREAS, Section 1104 of the Borough Code, as amended, provides that the offices of secretary and treasurer shall not be held by the same person, except in boroughs having less than two thousand five hundred inhabitants, when so authorized by ordinance; and,


WHEREAS, the Borough of New Berlin has less than two thousand five hundred inhabitants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW BERLIN, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of said Borough Council:


SECTION 1. The offices of secretary and treasurer of the Borough may hereinafter be held by the same person.

SECTION 2. The action of Borough Council in electing the same person to the offices of secretary and treasurer at its organization meeting held January 5, 1966 is hereby ratified.


