AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW BERLIN,
UNION COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING
ORDINANCE NO. 67-6, APPROVED DECEMBER 18,
1967, BY CHANGING THE SCHEDULE OF SEWER
RENTALS AND CHARGES, [REDACTED]

The Borough Council of the Borough of New Berlin, Union County,
Pennsylvania, ENACTS and ORDAINS as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance number 67-6, enacted December 18, 1967 is
hereby amended by changing the rates and classifications of Paragraph
B of Section 5.02, as follows:

A. Change category 3 to read in its entirety as follows:

"3. Each funeral parlor (to be in addition to any dwelling
units chargeable to the portion of a funeral home
used for residential purposes) 1"

B. Change category 4 to read in its entirety as follows:

"4. Each school, public or private:

- (a) toilet facilities and kitchen per 15 pupils
and employees or fraction thereof 1
- (b) toilet facilities and gymnasium per 12
pupils and employees or fraction thereof 1
- (c) toilet facilities, kitchen and gymnasium,
per 10 pupils and employees or fraction thereof 1"

C. Delete category 7.

D. In category 9, delete the word "club".

E. Change category 12 to read in its entirety as follows:

"12. Each service station or automobile repair garage 1"

F. Add a new category 16, as follows:

"16. Private club or lodge 3"

SECTION 2. Except as herein amended, said Ordinance No. 67-6 shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW BERLIN, UNION COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 67-6, ADOPTED DECEMBER 18, 1967, BY CHANGING THE SCHEDULE OF SEWER RENTALS AND CHARGES.

The Borough Council of the Borough of New Berlin, Union County, Pennsylvania, ENACTS and ORDAINS as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance number 67-6, enacted December 18, 1967 is hereby amended by changing the rates and classifications of Paragraph B of Section 5.02, as follows:

A. Change category 3 to read in its entirety as follows:

"3. Each funeral parlor (to be in addition to any dwelling units chargeable to the portion of a funeral home used for residential purposes.

B. Change category 4 to read in its entirety as follows:

- 4. Each school, public or private:
 - (a) toilet facilities and kitchen per 15 pupils and employees or fraction thereof 1
 - (b) toilet facilities and gymnasium per 12 pupils and employees or fraction thereof 1
 - (c) toilet facilities, kitchen and gymnasium, per 10 pupils and employees or fraction thereof 1

C. Delete category 7.

D. In category 9, delete the word "club".

E. Change category 12 to read in its entirety as follows:

"12. Each service station or automobile repair garage 1"

F. Add a new category 16, as follows:

"16. Private, club or lodge 3"

SECTION 2. Except as herein amended, said Ordinance No. 67-6, shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.
