

ORDINANCE NO. 14-1

An Ordinance providing for the cleaning of pavements, foot-walks, etc.

Section 1. That hereafter it shall be the duty of all owners of vacant properties and the occupants of improved premises in the Borough of New Berlin to keep their respective pavements, foot-walks, curbs and gutters in good repair and free from snow, ice, grass, weeds and other obstructions.

Section 2. That owners and occupiers of lots refusing or neglecting to comply, within five days, with written notice from the borough clerk that their respective pavements, foot-walks, curbs or gutters are not in the condition required under section 1, of this ordinance shall be liable to a fine of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$10.00 to be recovered for use of the said borough as like fines are, by law recoverable, excepting that the requirement to remove snow and ice may, at the discretion of the burgess, be upon 24 hours notice (instead of 5 days) after same shall cease to fall or form.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be, and the same are hereby repealed.
