

DISORDERLY PRACTICE

ORDINANCE NO. 60-2

Making it unlawful for any person to engage in, be connected with, commit, or be guilty of disorderly practices, disorderly or riotous assemblage, fights, affrays, boisterousnesses, drunkenness, breaches of the peace, or public indecencies, in and about the highways, public places, or elsewhere within the corporate limits of the Borough of New Berlin, and providing penalties for violation hereto.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW BERLIN, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, as follows.

SECTION 1: That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons, organization or organizations, firm or firms, corporation or corporations, to engage in, be connected with, commit, or be guilty of disorderly practices, disorderly or riotous assemblage, fights, affrays, boisterousness, drunkenness, breaches of the peace, or public indecencies, in and about the highways, public places, or elsewhere within the corporate limits of the Borough of New Berlin, to the disturbance of the public peace and/or against the good order and welfare of the inhabitants of the Borough of New Berlin.

SECTION 2: That if any person or persons, organization or organizations, firm or firms, corporation or corporations, shall be engaged in, connected with, commit, or be guilty of the acts prohibited by this ordinance, he she, it, or they, upon conviction thereof before the Chief Burgess or any Justice of the Peace of the said Borough of New Berlin, shall be required to pay a fine not exceeding ONE HUNDRED (\$100.00) DOLLARS and costs of prosecution, and in default of the payment of said fine and costs, shall be sentenced to imprisonment in the county jail for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days: and any corporation or corporations which shall permit or allow the provisions of this ordinance to be violated shall be subject to penalty of ONE HUNDRED (\$100.00) DOLLARS, to be recovered the same as debts in like amounts are now recoverable at law.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby expressly repealed.
