

BOROUGH OF NEW BERLIN

ORDINANCE NO. 52-2

Providing for the furnishing of electric service to the Borough of New Berlin, County of Union, Pennsylvania.

Whereas, there is now on file with the Borough Secretary, a form of agreement covering the supply of electric energy for the operation of the Borough's water pumping station and extensions thereof situated adjacent to the Borough of New Berlin, in Limestone Township, Union County, Pennsylvania.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of New Berlin and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

That the Borough of New Berlin, County of Union, Pennsylvania, enter into an agreement with Pennsylvania Power & Light Company for the furnishing of all the electric energy required by the Borough for the operation of the Borough's said water pumping station situated adjacent to the Borough of New Berlin, in Limestone Township, Union County, Pennsylvania, for the period and in accordance with the terms contained in the form of agreement now on file with the Borough Secretary for the furnishing of such service; and that the proper officers of the Borough be and they hereby are authorized and directed to execute and deliver said form of agreement on behalf of the Borough.

Enacted into an ordinance and passed by the Council of the Borough of New Berlin this 5th day of November, 1952.
